



Indonesia's economy sustainable growth improves its competitiveness to attract foreign direct investment. Within three years, the government has issued 16 economic packages in which superseded the unattractive regulations and policies. Incorporated to the economic packages, Government has provided fiscal and non-fiscal incentives such as exemption of import duties, tax allowance and additional facilities for industries in Special Economic Zones (SEZ). Moreover, major game-changing policy is the 3-hours licensing in which providing necessary documents to operate foreign investment business immediately. To supplement these policies, government has provided 32 industrial parks where investors are allowed to construct the building/factory directly after obtaining investment principle license from Indonesia Investment Coordinating Board (BKPM).

The policies have lead Indonesia to improve its "Ease of Doing Business" rank from 91 to 72 this year. Standard and Poor also has rated Indonesia as "**Investment Grade**" after 20 years.

In order to encourage, and at the same time to provide guidance and assistance to potential investors, the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in collaboration with Indonesia Investment Promotion Center (IIPC) in Singapore will hold **The 3<sup>rd</sup> Indonesia Investment Forum on 19 April 2018**. The Embassy will invite the Chairman of Indonesia Investment Coordinating Board as a keynote speaker. The program will be officially opened by the Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to Malaysia. The participants will have great opportunity to interact with these prominent persons.

### CHAIRMAN'S PROFILE

H.E. Thomas Trikasih Lembong, also known as Tom, is the Chairman of Indonesia Investment Coordinating Board. He was the Indonesian Minister of Trade from August 2015 to July 2016.

Prior his appointment in the cabinet, he has a long professional record. In 1994, Mr. Lembong started his career at Morgan Stanley and Company as a Sales and Trading Associate. Then, he worked at Equities Division of Morgan Stanley (Singapore), served as Senior Manager at Corporate Finance Department of Makindo, and Investment Banker of Deutsche Securities Indonesia.

Between 2002 and 2005, Mr. Lembong served as Division Head and Senior Vice President at the Indonesian Bank Restructuring Agency (IBRA). He is employed with Principia Management Group, and was a Managing Partner and CEO at Quvat Management, a private equity fund established in 2006.

Mr. Tom Lembong received a Bachelor's degree (Bachelor of Arts) majoring in Architecture and Urban Design from Harvard University in Cambridge, USA in 1994. He also was elected as Young Global Leader (YGL) by the World Economic Forum (WEF) in 2008.



### THE AMBASSADOR'S PROFILE

H.E. Rusdi Kirana is the Ambassador of the Republic of Indonesia to



Malaysia. He previously held position as the member of the Presidential Advisory Council from 2015 until his appointment as the Ambassador.

He founded and led his business group as the Executive Director for PT Lion Group and PT Lion Mentari. Due to his maverick business undertakings, he was awarded *Legion d'Honneur* by French President in 2017 and named "Indonesia Most Admired CEO" in 2013 by *Warta Ekonomi Magazine*. His lasting business achievements include purchasing the largest amounts of French Airbus A320 and Boeing B737 from US in 2011.
